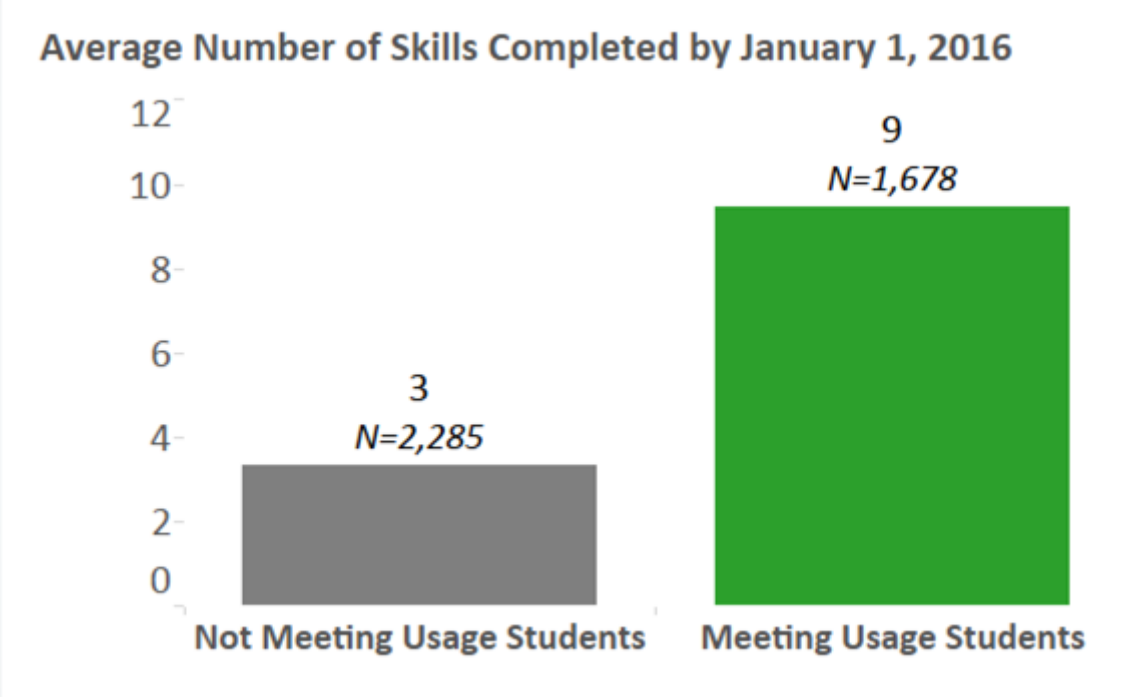

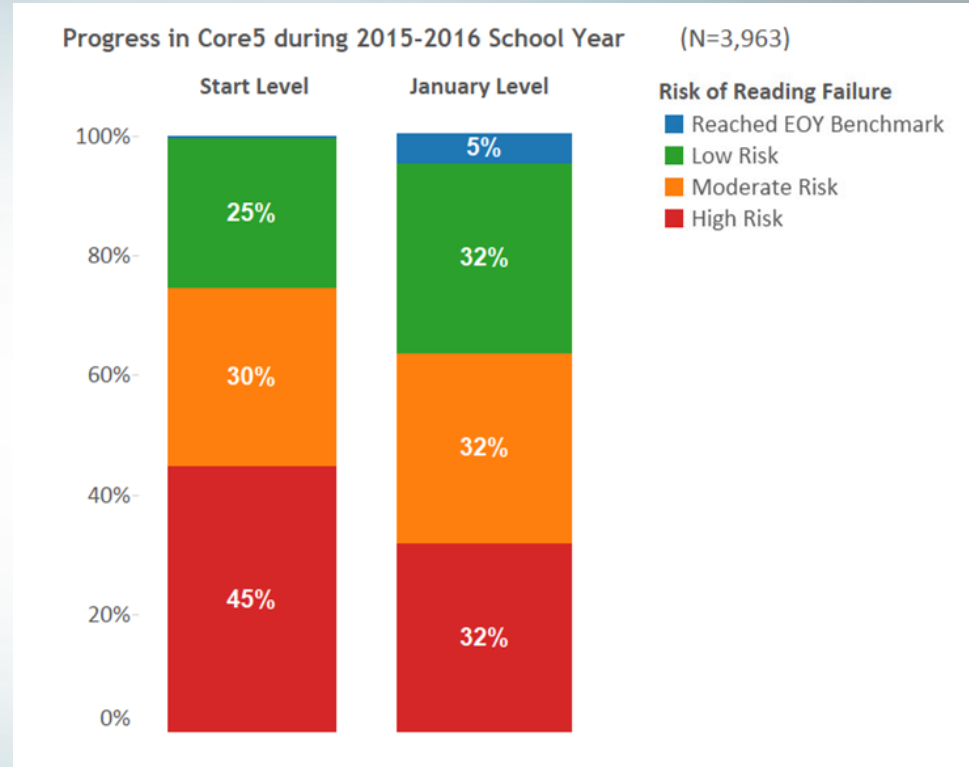

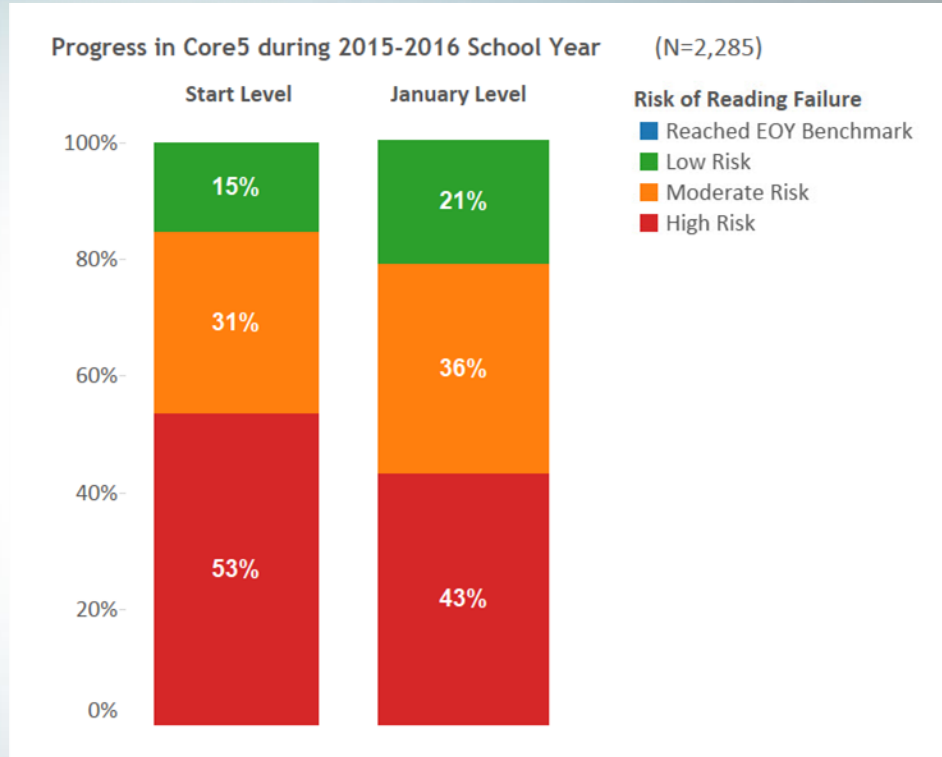

-decreased by 10%

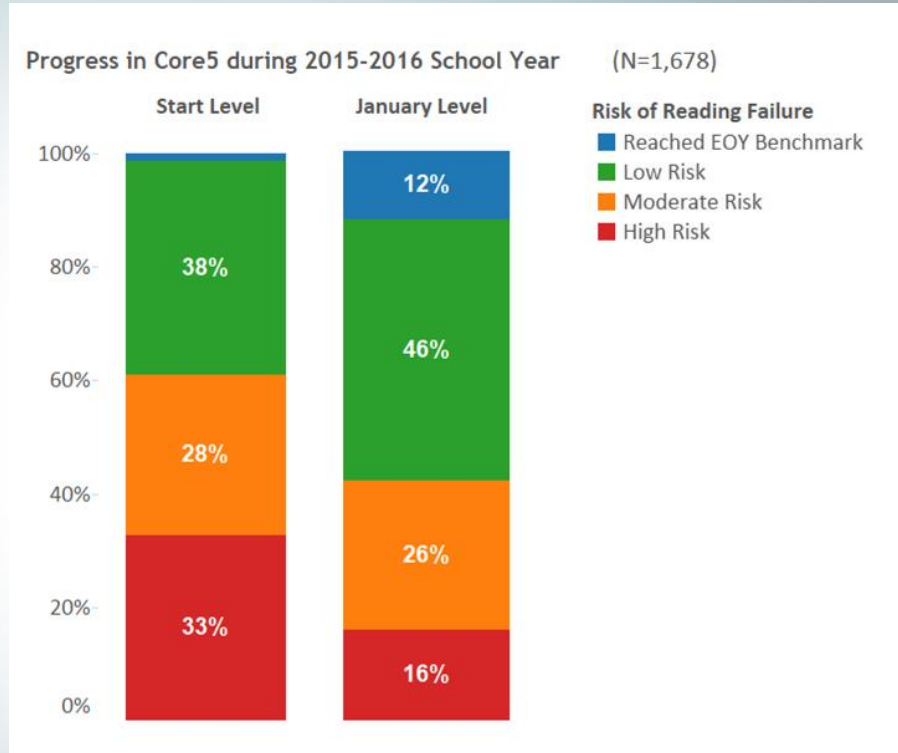


Review of District Level Data - Intensive Schools

-decreased by 17%

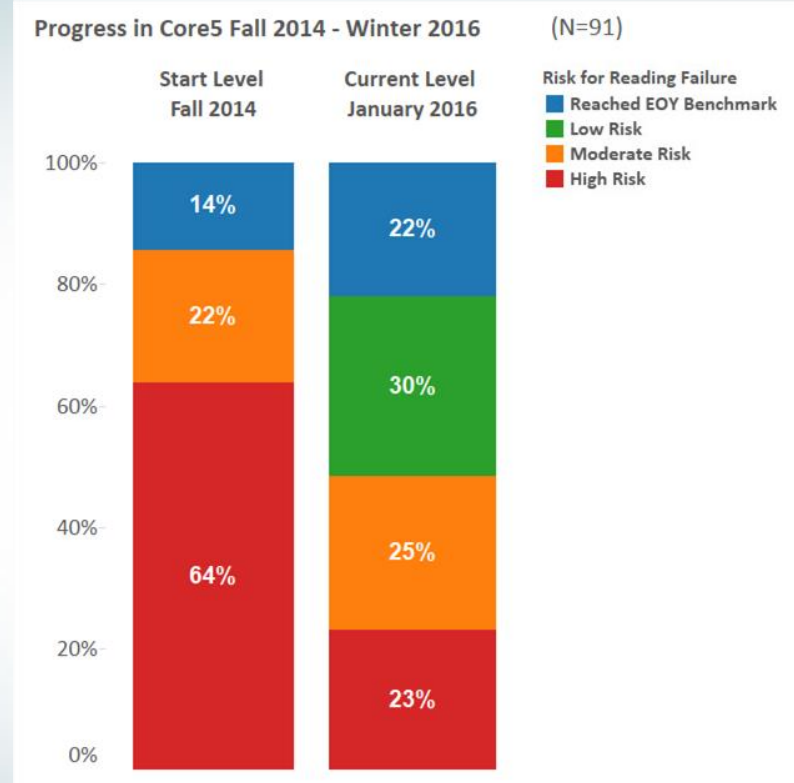

(91 students)

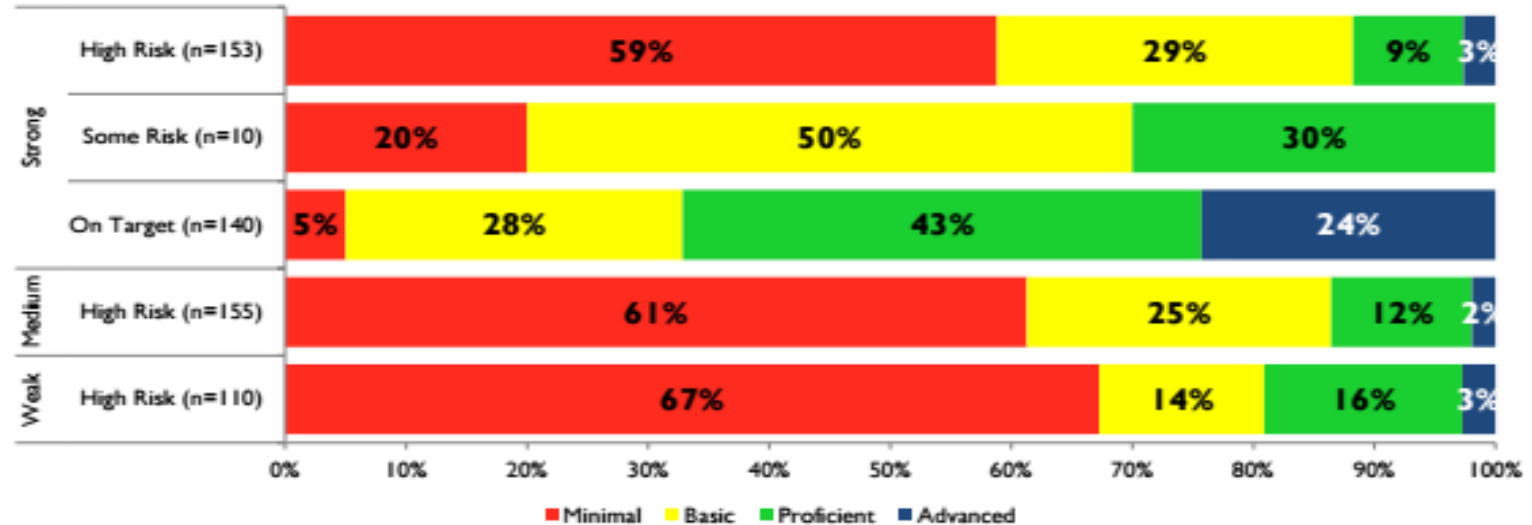
Reached EOY/Low Risk -

2nd Semester: Opportunities for Growth

1. Increase Student Usage and Access to Lexia

Ideas:

- During Reach time
- WIN block
- Consider other times outside of school hours, such as after school and home use

2. Increase Staff Usage

Ideas:

- Examine data to look at who are top staff users
- Have teachers share ways they are incorporating Lexia into routines
- Provide support to look at Lexia as grade level teams



2nd Semester: Opportunities for Growth

3. Increase explicit instruction when students are flagged

Ideas:

- Teachers look at myLexia to identify students who are flagged for additional support on a consistent basis
- Teachers use core resources to target student needs (Mondo Phonics, F&P, Lexia Lessons)
